Altima Spuds Chambers 14-35-41-11 W5M Well

February 19, 2013 - Altima Resources Ltd. (TSX-V: ARH / FSE: AKC / OTC Pink: ARSLF) announces the Altima Chambers 14-35-41-11 W5M well spud on February 16, 2013 and drilled to a depth of 632 meters where casing was set. The 14-35 well is to be drilled to a depth of approximately 3,090 meters into the Nordegg formation.

The 14-35 well is the first well drilled under Altima's Participation Agreement with Whistler Oil and Gas Pty. Ltd. (refer to News Release January 24, 2013). The 14-35 well is located approximately 5 kilometers to the north of the COPOL ET AL HZ CHAMBERS 14-15-41-11 W5M well drilled and completed in 2012.
